



SENIOR FARMERS MARKET NUTRITION PROGRAM

Provides eligible seniors with checks to purchase Pennsylvania grown produce at participating Farmers Markets

- **Eligibility**

- ◆ Age 60 or older by December 31, 2019
- ◆ Westmoreland County resident
- ◆ **Income Guidelines**
 - 1 Person \$ 23,107
 - 2 People \$ 31,284
 - 3 People \$ 39,461
 - 4 People \$ 47,638
 - 5 People \$ 55,815

*Income (ALL income – including Social Security, Black Lung, Wages, Interest Earnings, Pensions, etc.)

- \$20 worth of checks per person. **LIMIT: one** sign-up per person per year.
- Checks expire November 30, 2019.
- Residents of personal care homes, nursing homes, and convents where meals are provided are **NOT** eligible.
- Homebound individuals may have someone apply for them providing the required verification of age, residency and completed **proxy form.
- **Checks are limited and will be distributed, as scheduled, based upon availability. No checks will be issued prior to the start time listed below.**

***Applicants** – Please bring proof of age & residency such as a driver's license, photo identification card, birth certificate, baptismal certificate, utility receipts showing address, PACE card, AAA red or green card. Note - Medicare and Social Security Cards are **NOT** acceptable proof of age.
